Using a Barrier to Limit Airborne Exposure or Droplets

This image shows barriers that were used to protect two individuals who were required to work within close proximity (6 feet) of each other during week-long job installing underground cast iron piping in a trench. The 3'6"x7' droplet barrier was fabricated using 6-millimeter plastic sheeting attached to a 2in x 4in lumber frame. Note: Workers should wear facing coverings even with the barrier.
